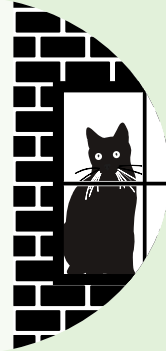

Coyote Tracks



Front Track: 2 3/4" long



Hind track: 2" long

Tracks will show considerable variations depending upon the condition of the ground (clay, mud, dust, sand, etc.) and movement of the coyote.
